Your responsibilities include defining the features of new/modified offerings, prioritizing features, adjusting features and re-setting priorities as needed after each sprint/iteration, accepting or rejecting work results, and keeping the internal customers informed on status as well as gaining their feedback. The Product Owner is also responsible for working closely with Product Managers to ensure that product(s) vision, roadmap, artifacts, and backlog are all in alignment.
